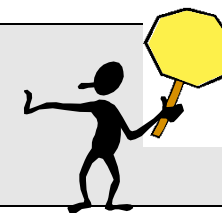


# Look for the Signals



Signal	How it Sounds	Example
Comma ,	Pause; placement affects meaning	Jack, my dog is as fast as you. Jack, my dog, is as fast as you.
Period .	Need a longer pause	The football player scored a touchdown. There was a penalty.
Question Mark ?	Raise voice at the end of the sentence	Are you hungry?
Exclamation Mark !	Emotion	You made an A!
<u>Underlined</u> or <b>bold</b> print	Need for special stress	She is <u>angry</u> . <b>She</b> is angry.
