

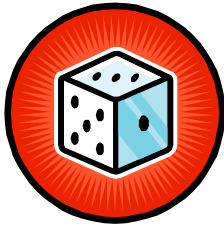


Four in a Row



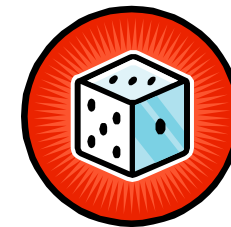

Four in a Row

Materials: 1 game board, 1 foam dice, two colors of game pieces

Directions: Fill in the playing card with student's spelling words, or content area words, etc. Students roll dice to see who goes first. High roller can either go first or choose color of gamepiece.

First player rolls the dice. Must find a word with the same number rolled. Player must say the word and use it in a sentence. If correct, place a marker. Next player continues. First person to get 4 of their game pieces in a row wins.
